- Psychology
- Pharmacy.

Once patients are admitted to the hospital a comprehensive rehabilitation assessment will be undertaken. The rehabilitation team and the patient will develop a personal program to meet the patient's goals and rehabilitation needs.





Inpatient Rehabilitation

Eden Rehabilitation Hospital provides a wide range of specialty inpatient programs. Patients can be referred for any of the following needs:

Orthopaedic Rehabilitation

- Post joint replacement
- Post amputation
- Amputee gait retraining
- Post fracture
- Spinal injuries and spinal surgery
- Arthritis
- Pain management.

Neurological Rehabilitation

- Stroke rehabilitation
- Parkinson's Disease
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Motor Neurone Disease
- Post neurosurgery
- Spinal cord injury
- Acquired Brain Injury (ABI).

Reconditioning Rehabilitation

- Recovering from surgery
- Debilitation due to chronic disease
- Mobility and balance retraining
- Following deconditioning from acute illness
- Falls prevention.

Cost

Eden Rehabilitation Hospital has agreements with most private health funds and Work Cover. We also have Tier One Provider Status with the Department of Veteran's Affairs.

Eden's admissions team will check the patient is fully covered prior to their admission.

There are no out-of-pocket costs if patients have appropriate cover.

What To Bring

Patients are required to wear comfortable and loose fitting clothing and supportive and enclosed shoes throughout their therapy. Patients are welcome to wear casual clothing outside of their therapy.
